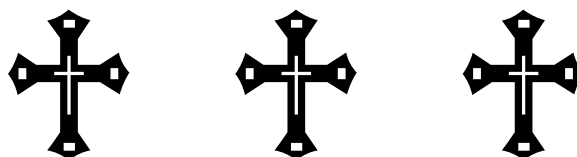

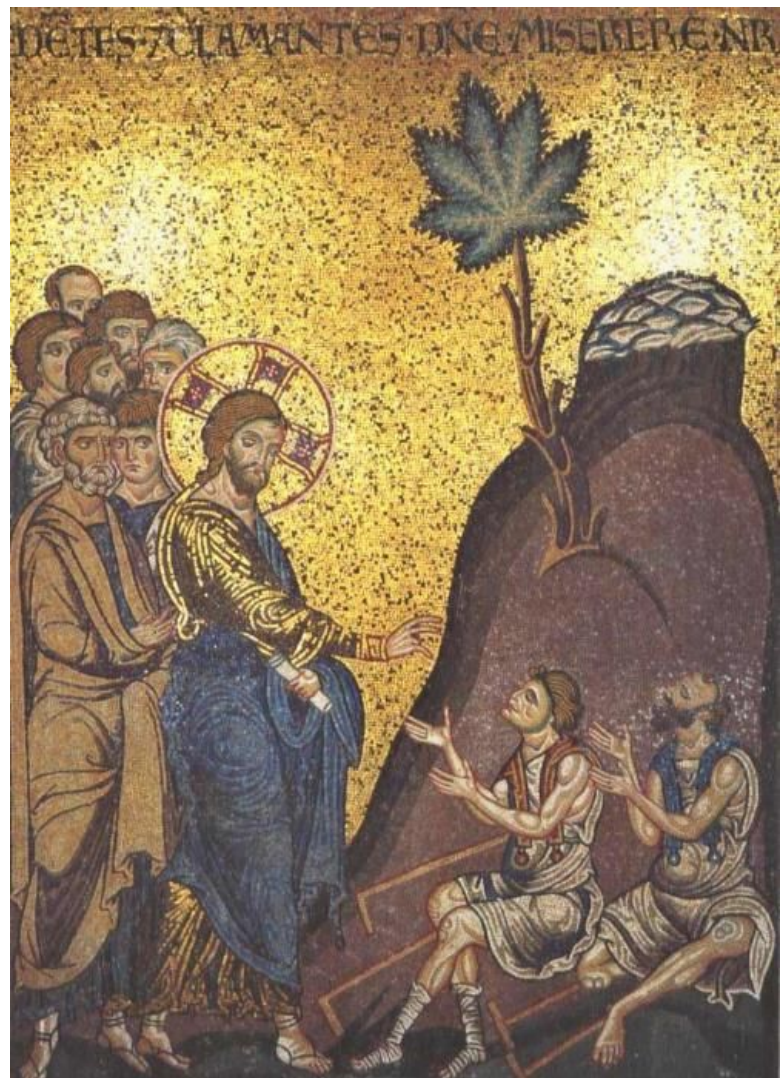

The Healing of the Two Blind Men

Myron Badnerosky

July 05, 2021



Myron M. Badnerosky, formerly of Levittown, PA, passed away peacefully at Tidewell Hospice in Lakewood Ranch, FL. His longtime advocate, companion, confident and friend “Martha” Kay McFarland was at his side. Myron was born in McKeesport, PA. He was the son of the late Michael Andrew and Anna (Molnar) Badnerosky. He is survived by his cousins, Nadine Herceg, Trevor Herceg and Tanya Martynik of Endicott, NY plus the Dowling and Klimow families. Myron graduated from McKeesport Public School System in 1948. Went to Lisle Benedictine University until the opening of St. Cyril and Methodius Byzantine Seminary in 1950 and graduated from Duquesne University with honors in 1952. He continued at St Cyril and Methodius until 1956. Myron was ordained to the priesthood on Pentecost Sunday, May 20, 1956. After a few years in other parishes, in 1959, Bishop Elko sent Fr. Myron to Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church of the Byzantine Rite where he remained until his retirement in 2018. This past May was his 65th Anniversary as a priest in the Byzantine Catholic Rite. Fr. Myron was an excellent administrator. He took a struggling parish, 300 thousand dollars in debt turned it around, paid off the mortgage on the hall, began work on the new church which was dedicated in 1964 and paid that debt off within 10 years. With his 59 years of service, he had a few fourth generation families in the parish. OLPH continues today with a small but dedicated group of parishioners. Fr. Myron designed OLPH and it is still regarded as a premiere landmark today. Upon retirement, Myron and “Martha” settled in Bougainvillea Place a small community in Ellenton, FL. He dearly loved his new friends and neighbors. The relaxed Florida lifestyle suited him. In retirement, Myron wanted to be accepted due to friendship not clerical connections. One and all loved Myron. He bonded with the men due to his love of antique cars, the ladies loved to talk with Myron because was such a “good listener” and his sense of humor kept one and all on their toes. His love for his little boy in a furry suit, “S’ami” was legendary. Just like at OLPH “Martha” was there to help Myron and S’ami. Myron often said he exchanged his OLPH families for his BP families and loved every minute of it.
