

BIG NEWS...

After months and months (and months!!!!) of prep work, the buildings out front are ready to come down! Demolition is slated to begin on **Monday, October 4, 2021** (pending final permits are issued on time)! The entire process should take roughly 3 weeks, hopefully less. There is, however, one caveat.

Due to the schedule of CTC Demolition, in conjunction with longer than usual lead times for the materials for the electric work (due to world wide shipping delays), there is a very good chance that the hall will be demolished BEFORE the electric lines are re-routed. This means that we will, for a few weeks, have to run the church on a diesel generator. While I am well aware that this is not at all ideal, it is what we have to do. We will be inconvenienced for a few weeks, but that is about it.

Ultimately, we should all prepare for several weeks of upheaval at OLPH because of the massive amount of work that will be occurring on our property. Let's all just go with the flow!

I have been working on this project every day since April 23 and believe me, I am very much looking forward to this all being done, as I am sure you all are as well. Let us all pray that in the coming weeks everything goes smoothly and that we bring these projects to a close and look toward the future.

Speaking of the future (wink, wink!), once the buildings are down we can look toward fund raising (hint, hint!) for a MUCH NEEDED new parking lot and to the renovation of the interior of the Church!
